Bourbon Sirocco is the first waterjet propelled offshore crew/supply boat designed with a wave-piercing bow. This increases the waterline length to improve seaworthiness & speed to power ratio. She utilises a DP2 system to control the waterjets and bow thrusters for precise station keeping. Bourbon Sirocco is currently configured to carry 60 passengers but has a maximum capacity of 80 passengers.
